I'd also ask each of you to be very reverent, and refrain from speaking in the vestibule and congregation area. We are not coming to be seen, heard, or for fellowship, but to WORSHIP Him silently. And please do not fellowship in the parking lot after prayer, but go home in the same Spirit.

It is my grand privilege today to set this appointment up for a personal interview between you and our Lord Jesus. May it be a blessing to each of you and your families.
